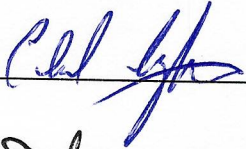
Chief Duvall submitted his resignation letter to Trustee Moyer, effective 11/01/2026.

Chief discussed the radio frequency and communication with other departments and costs associated. BRIX is currently a free system for utilization but has had some issues lately. To reprogram our MARCS radios to allow ease of communication with some departments would cost \$5000.00 through JD Johnson. Another alternative to BRIX is ACTIVE 911. That would cost the department approx. \$250 per year for the subscription with a limited # of people (approx. 15). The Board discussed and approved the

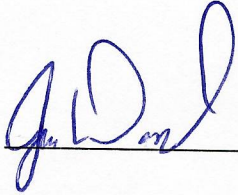
Further Business
