August 20, 2025

Chad Ashbaugh, Chairman called the Rushcreek Township Trustee Board meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Pledge to American Flag

VISITORS

Dee Mowry- Past Potentate, Aladdin Shriner's presenting a check. Picture was taken with Mr. Mowry and he gave a brief history of the work Aladdin Shriner's does to support these grants. Trustee Moyer and Chief Duvall graciously accepted the funds. A picture will be posted on the Fire Department FB page. In addition, Mr. Mowry expressed his appreciation to the Board for the improvements to the roads in the Township.

Sharon Herring- Questions regarding necessity and timing of Chip Seal Project on her road. Concerned whether or not her road should be chip sealed since it was a dead end. Also concerned about emergency vehicles being able to access during chip seal. On a separate topic expressed concern about a closed cemetery being mowed on a more regular basis. Trustee Ashbaugh addressed her concerns regarding chip seal by stating the last remaining roads in the Township were being sealed. He explained how the continuity of all roads being sealed reduces several processes for the Township. Purchasing extra stone throughout the year, ability to plow and treat all roads the same in the winter and a better surface for emergency vehicles to travel. Trustee Ashbaugh also advised that we make every effort to mow all closed cemeteries 2x per year. This year has been difficult due to excess moisture. The Road department would make every effort to mow them one more time this year. We had more volunteers in the past to mow prior to Memorial and Labor Day. Ms. Herring asked if this could be subcontracted for more consistent mowing. The Board does not feel that is possible at this time with tax payer \$ for closed cemeteries.

Zoning

BZA meeting for Estep on 8/13. BZA voted 4 to 1 no current violation based on evidence presented regarding occupant in business property. Any other matters were not detailed in the violation letter therefore not considered. County PA's were present .

Permit application from D. Cain for new construction at 9683 Webb Summit Road

Chapman – Geneva School requested extension. Trustee Moyer stated they would receive a 6 mos. Extension for the permit.

Trustee Moyer expressed his concern over temporary (inflatable) pools requiring a permit. The language in the Zoning Resolution appears to be geared toward in ground pools and fences and the requirement of insurance. Trustee Moyer will contact the Zoning Commission to add to their agenda to consider changes. The Board feels we can not enforce some of the requirements particularly regarding insurance. We have no authority to verify such items on an initial on annual basis and no way of knowing if an insurance company would require a fence around these types of pools.

Road Department

Administration

County Engineer will be providing information on \$ prior to the next meeting for the culvert project on Tent Church Road. They will also provide \$\$ remaining in the culvert fund which we can utilize for the Zion Road culvert project for Force Account purposes.

Further Business:

Check for Mr. Bruce Kelley in the amount of \$432.00 for the garage door repair as a result of mowing debris.

The Board discussed the property on Geneva School and the Land Grant that was suppose to demolish and deed the property to the surrounding land owners. Trustee Downard will follow up with the Land Bank to find a status. A letter had been sent two years ago by Trustee Downard requesting a status and a response received that it was scheduled to be demolished.

Several used and new trucks have been viewed by the different members of the Board. Trustee Moyer, presented a truck the appears to meet the stated needs. A 2019 F550, diesel with a dump bed, approx. 39,812 miles. Asking price is \$58,500.00. It does not have a plow. The truck is currently located in Maryland and belongs to United Rentals. They advised Trustee Moyer is we are interested in the truck they will have it sent to Marietta for the Board to view.
