Chief stated the departments intention to apply for the Ohio Department of Commerce Fire Marshall grant in the max amount of \$15,000.00 for 3 sets of gear. Lisa asked if we should consider applying for attack line again rather than replacement gear. Chief indicated his thoughts this was rarely approved but would follow up. The grant is due by the end of January. Chief stated that FF Graham had reviewed all of the gear and dates to determine what was needed.
