An email was received from Fairfield County EMS Director Jon Kochis stating there was a lightning strike at the siren on Houck Road which damaged the battery charger beyond repairs. They had a spare which was installed so the siren is currently working. Jon stated that a new battery plus charger would be approximately \$1,000.00.

After discussion Hart made a motion to approve the purchase of a new battery and charger up to \$1,100.00 for the Houck Road siren and Bill seconded the motion. Roll Call: Hart, aye; Bill, aye.
